

Kapi'olani Community College's Community Mixed Plate Art Exhibit



Who can enter?

One grade level per school (each class in the selected grade level can enter an exhibit)

What's the theme?

Food! Anything to do with food: growing, producing, preparing, sharing, eating, presenting it. Favorite food, traditional food, holiday food. Anything at all.

What materials can be used?

KCC will provide one piece of 32"x40" black foam core board and one 30" circle of white foam core board cut into segments. Students in each class in the selected grade level can decorate the segments in any way they like, using whatever materials they like. Once the segments have been decorated, then they are to be glued on the black foam core to re-form the circle. Each class should identify its exhibit by adding the name of the school, the grade level, and the teacher's name on the piece of black foam core.

What's the timeline?

KCC will deliver the foam core boards to schools on the date determined by the participating teachers. **Entries are due at KCC by 4:30 pm on August 11, 2008**, and should be dropped off at 'Ilima 206 (a campus map is available at www.kcc.hawaii.edu/page/campusmap). Students' art pieces will be on display August 18-23, 2008.

Will there be prizes?

Yes, prize winners will be selected by KCC art faculty. Visitors to the exhibit will also have an opportunity to select the winner of the "Viewer's Choice" award, which will be announced on the last day of the exhibit, August 23.
